General Rules:

Participants are requested to read all rules governing this show. For English classes, the Saskatchewan Horse Federation rules will apply and for Western classes, the WSDAC rules will apply.

This event requires **proof of negative Coggin's** within 180 days of event. Negative Coggin's documentation **must** be provided with your show entry form. Entries will not be processed until this document is received.

All riders **MUST** wear an approved ASTM or SEI approved helmet at all times while mounted on show grounds as required by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

Show Rules:

All riders must be current members of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

Numbers must be worn by all horses when not stabled. This includes hand-walking while on property, lunging, warm-ups, and while in the competition ring. Riders must provide their own numbers.

Schooling is permitted in designated areas only. Lunging is permitted in designated areas only. Horses and riders are restricted to competition at 2 consecutive levels.

Each horse is restricted to a maximum of 4 tests per day, regardless of rider.

All classes are being run as Junior and Senior with no age designations between junior levels.

Ride times will be assigned and published on the Saskatoon Dressage Club FaceBook page.

It is the responsibility of riders to present themselves at the in-gate promptly at their assigned ride times. Riders who do not arrive on time will be eliminated from the class and forfeit their entry fees.

Abuse or inhumane treatment of horses, as well as unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Show management reserves the right to excuse those who are witnessed to commit such offenses.

The judge may not be directly approached. Any issues shall be taken to the show committee. Readers will not be provided. Riders must arrange their own reader.

Hors concurs tests are permitted. The test fee remains the same.

The gate will not be closed for any test with the only possible exception being the para tests if deemed necessary.

Liability

It is to be understood that neither EasteEdge Equestrian, Saskatoon Dressage Club, SHF, WSDAC, the show committee, judges, volunteers, or show manager shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to competitors or anyone on the ground during the competition or to any animal or property brought on show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or any journey to and from the show.

Release of Liability form must be signed by all riders or guardians and included with show entry form in order for entries to be processed.

Facility:

Stabling is mandatory. Weekend stalls will be available for occupation at 11:00 am Friday June 7th. Stall assignments will be posted. There is to be no stall moving or swapping permitted unless prior permission is granted by the show office. Shavings are available for pre-purchase for \$10.00/bale. Shavings and straw are the only permitted bedding to be used. Straw must be supplied by the individual, there will be no straw available for purchase.

Dogs are discouraged. If brought, they must be leashed at **all times**.

Warm-up Time Request form: Friday June 17th

Rules:

1. Half hour time blocks may be purchased for \$30.00 (see entry form). Payment must be attached with the warm up request form. Cheques payable to the Saskatoon Dressage Club.
2. Time slots can be purchased by individuals or by a group. All horse/riders must be entered in the competition to be eligible for a warm up time.
3. Saskatoon Dressage Club will not be responsible for grouping people together to share the ring and will not enforce time slots. Please manage your time accordingly and ensure you exit the ring upon the conclusion of your booking.
4. Each horse rider is restricted to book only 1 time slot. Riders may only book multiple times if different horses are being ridden.
5. All warm up requests will be scheduled on a first come first served basis.
6. All riders must be current members of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.
7. Riders will be notified of the warm up schedule by June 5th via email.
8. Professional etiquette must be maintained by all riders, trainers, owners, and parents at all times. 9. Riders will not be permitted to ride around the warm up ring unless warm up time is booked.
10. There will be an additional warm up ring available for use at no extra charge.
11. Lunging is forbidden both in and around the competition ring at all times. Other areas will be available for lunging.
